



Annual Stakeholder Survey Results Completed June 2024

Each year at we conduct a range of stakeholder surveys. We survey our pupils and our parent/carers to gauge the areas in which we are doing well and explore the areas we may need to improve.

We ask stakeholders a range of questions which ask for views on the school ethos; teaching and learning; the school community and overall satisfaction.

The results from our surveys are overwhelmingly positive. Both the Parent and Pupil surveys are extremely positive about our school ethos, the quality of teaching and the learning opportunities that we provide.

Parent/Carer Survey

We received 108 responses to the parent/carers survey and the results were very encouraging.

99% of parent/carers agree that the school is friendly and welcoming

97% of parent/carers feel that their child's emotional wellbeing and development is well supported.

98% of parent/carers state the school is well led and managed

97% of parent/carers would recommend this school to a friend

Here is a selection of parent comments from the June 2024 survey:

Pupil Survey

We received 172 responses to the parent/carer survey and the results were very encouraging.

98% of pupils say they are proud to come to this school

97% of pupils say this is a good school
