



Annual Stakeholder Survey Results Completed JULY 2025

Each year at we conduct a range of stakeholder surveys. We survey our pupils and our parent/carers to gauge the areas in which we are doing well and explore the areas we may need to improve.

We ask stakeholders a range of questions which ask for views on the school ethos; teaching and learning; the school community and overall satisfaction.

The results from our surveys are overwhelmingly positive. Both the Parent and Pupil surveys are extremely positive about our school ethos, the quality of teaching and the learning opportunities that we provide.

Parent/Carer Results 2025

We received **101** responses to the parent/carers survey and the results were very encouraging.
